2016 PHOTOGRAPHER OF THE YEAR

For the THIRD time in four years, LISA MANDELKERN has been chosen the 2016 Photographer of the Year by the Dona Ana Photography Club. The award is based on the quality and excellence of her photos submitted throughout the year in 3 quarterly print competitions and the digital Photo of the Year contest. Lisa has consistently created outstanding photos with high artistic and technical content. Her

background in art and art history, plus her natural enthusiasm for exploring new digital photographic topics, has made her a master at her craft. She has been the DAPC's Program Chair for the last five years and frequently gives illustrated lectures on how to create better photos. One of Lisa's night sky photographs is currently on the cover of the new NMSU Library 2017 Calendar.

Her photo titled "A Time Before the Latest" won the DAPC Members' Choice Award and was created using HDR by combining 3 photos with different light exposures to capture all of the details perfectly, including the outdoor landscape.

Lisa describe the

scene: "This photo was taken in Germany at the Beuren open air museum. There, one can visit about ten or so historic farmers' houses from the Southwestern region of Germany. The houses come from different counties, and were reassembled stone by stone at the museum site. Each house is slightly different, but most have one thing in common. Everything a family needed was gathered under one roof: living quarters, barn and life stock stable. The photo shows a kitchen in one of the farm houses. This kitchen bears a striking resemblance to a kitchen my family had in the late nineteen-fifties. The sink, faucet, dishes, furniture and tablecloth are the standard of the day. Things were simple, practical and built to last. Our kitchen was well used. Breakfasts, lunches and dinners were prepared by my mom from scratch every day. In the afternoon, we kids would do our homework at the kitchen table. My memories are sketchy at best, but they look a lot like this photo: it is summer and the kitchen is filled with mellow light and with wonderful aromas."

PHOTOGRAPHY BOOT CAMP WORKSHOPS

Did you recently get a new camera? Do you have a camera sitting on a shelf because you haven't figured out how to use it? Maybe you've got a camera but you want to get more use out of it?

The Doña Ana Photography Club is offering Photography "Boot Camp" Workshops to the community. This 5-part series is aimed at anyone new to photography, anyone wanting to learn how to better use his or her camera, or anyone with questions about photography and how to take better photographs. The Boot Camp series will start with "Learning About Your Camera", and include a total of five courses covering topics, such as getting your camera off automatic mode, taking better photographs, and editing, and will conclude with a final question and answer session along with an opportunity to have your images critiqued. Courses will be led by a member of the Doña Ana Photography Club with several club members present to help answer questions and assist during hands-on

segments.

The Photography Boot Camp is open to the public. Registration is required and the cost is \$5 per course for non-photography club members. DAPC members may attend for free. Non-photography club members may join for \$15 (which covers your annual membership) then attend the boot camp classes free of charge.
